

Statement of Candidacy for Council Election

Each year, an election brochure with candidate statements and background is distributed to APEGBC members. Each candidate provides individual information for this brochure.

Nominees are asked to provide:

- **A Candidate's Statement.** The statement should include your personal goals or objectives should you be elected to APEGBC's Council, and key biographical information. **Council election statements are limited to 800 words for presidential and vice presidential candidates, and 400 words for councillor candidates, including all reference information** (education, professional history, etc.).
- **A headshot** (photograph of head and shoulders). The photo should be high resolution (300 dpi or higher), and it is recommended that there be good contrast between yourself and the background of the photograph.

Please be aware that Candidates' Statements will not be edited for grammar or spelling. It is strongly recommended that you have your statement proofread prior to submitting it to the Association. Should you wish to publish additional information about your suitability for election, you are welcome to reference an external website. Please note that all candidate statements must conform to *APEGBC's Election Policy* (attached).

In order to ensure inclusion in the brochure, your candidate election statement and photograph must be received at the Association office by **Friday, July 24, 2009**.
