**NOTICE OF INQUIRY**

**TAKE NOTICE** that a Panel of the Discipline Committee of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of British Columbia (the "Association"), will meet at Suite 200, 4010 Regent Street, in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia on **Wednesday the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2010**, at the hour of 9:30 in the forenoon for the purpose of taking evidence or otherwise causing an inquiry to be made with respect to the allegation herein pursuant to the ***Engineers and Geoscientists Act***, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 116, as amended (the "**Act**").

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the allegation against you is that contrary to the **Act**, you have demonstrated unprofessional conduct by your design of a repair to a septic field for a property on Sinclair Bay Road, Garden Bay, B.C. ("Project"), resulting in the septic field being approximately one half the required size, in that, the design and construction of the Project was not in accordance with appropriate practice, the Ministry of Health's publication *Sewerage System Standard Practice Manual* ("**SPM**") or the *Sewerage System Regulation* (326/2004) ("**SSR**") in one or more of the following areas:

- (a) you failed to verify the uses that the Project would serve;
- (b) in your signed and sealed Record of Sewerage System, dated March 23, 2006, accepted for filing by the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority on March 24, 2006 ("**ROSS**"), you incorrectly described the site of the Project as a campground;
- (c) in the **ROSS** you incorrectly calculated the estimated daily sewerage flow for the Project;
- (d) you failed to file with the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority a letter of certification, within 30 days of completion of construction of the Project, as required by section 9 of the **SSR**;

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that you, Dale Allenback, P.Eng., have the right, at your own expense, to be represented by counsel at the inquiry by the Panel of the Discipline Committee and you or your counsel shall have the full right to cross-examine all witnesses called and to call evidence in defence and reply in answer to the allegations.

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that in the event of your non-attendance at the inquiry, the Panel of the Discipline Committee may, upon proof of service of this Notice of Inquiry upon you, proceed with the taking of evidence or otherwise ascertaining the facts concerning the allegations, despite your absence, and may make its findings on the facts and its decision without further notice to you.
