**TAKE NOTICE** that a Panel of the Discipline Committee of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of British Columbia (the "Association"), will meet at Suite 200, 4010 Regent Street, in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia on **Wednesday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2007**, at the hour of 9:30 in the forenoon for the purpose of taking evidence or otherwise causing an inquiry to be made with respect to the allegation herein pursuant to the ***Engineers and Geoscientists Act***, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 116, as amended (the "**Act**").

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the allegation against you is that, contrary to the **Act**, you have demonstrated unprofessional conduct in your April 1, 2004 structural design drawings and shop drawing review for a retail building at 215 Port Augusta Street, Comox, B.C., because of one or more of the following:

1. the roof deck shear forces at the skylight openings in the area of gridlines H to J and 1 to 5 exceed the roof deck shear capacity;
2. in the area of gridlines H to J and 1 to 2 ("clipped roof area"):
  - (a) a lack of a drag strut connection at the intersection of gridlines H and 2;
  - (b) the design does not address the continuity of diaphragm chord in the clipped roof area;
3. you did not have a shop drawing evidencing an adequate joist seat to transfer roof deck shear forces from the perimeter angle to edge beams and brace bays on gridlines 1 and 5;
4. the brace bay column foundations on gridline J are inadequate to resist the brace bay overturning forces; or
5. a lack of a concept review of this structural design by a member or licensee not originally involved in the design. ;

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that you, Tam A. London, P.Eng., have the right, at your own expense, to be represented by counsel at the inquiry by the Panel of the Discipline Committee and you or your counsel shall have the full right to cross-examine all witnesses called and to call evidence in defence and reply in answer to the allegation.

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that in the event of your non-attendance at the inquiry, the Panel of the Discipline Committee may, upon proof of service of this Notice of Hearing upon you, proceed with the taking of evidence or otherwise ascertaining the facts concerning the allegation, despite your absence, and may make its findings on the facts and its decision without further notice to you.
