NOTICE OF INQUIRY

TAKE NOTICE that a Panel of the Discipline Committee of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of British Columbia (the "Association"), will meet at Suite 200, 4010 Regent Street, in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia on **Wednesday the 15th day of September, 2010**, at the hour of 9:30 in the forenoon for the purpose of taking evidence or otherwise causing an inquiry to be made with respect to the allegation herein pursuant to the **Engineers and Geoscientists Act**, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 116, as amended (the "**Act**").

AND TAKE NOTICE that the allegation against you is that contrary to the **Act**, you have demonstrated unprofessional conduct, in that, after signing a Letter of Undertaking to the Association's Practice Review Committee dated December 7, 2005 ("Letter of Undertaking") in which you undertook:

I will no longer seek new contracts for work which involves the provision of professional engineering advice or consulting services on matters related to building envelope engineering unless:

- a. It is under the direct supervision of a professional engineer having specialized expertise in building envelope engineering who is approved in advance, in writing, by the Practice Review Committee; or*
- b. I have successfully completed a training program in building envelope engineering which includes components of education and experience that has been approved in advance, in writing, by the Practice Review Committee.*

you performed 11 building envelope consulting projects without first complying with either of these provisions in the Letter of Undertaking.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that you, Robert Bruce Cheadle, P.Eng., have the right, at your own expense, to be represented by counsel at the inquiry by the Panel of the Discipline Committee and you or your counsel shall have the full right to cross-examine all witnesses called and to call evidence in defence and reply in answer to the allegation.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that in the event of your non-attendance at the inquiry, the Panel of the Discipline Committee may, upon proof of service of this Notice of Inquiry upon you, proceed with the taking of evidence or otherwise ascertaining the facts concerning the allegation, despite your absence, and may make its findings on the facts and its decision without further notice to you.
