**TAKE NOTICE** that a Panel of the Discipline Committee of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of British Columbia (the "Association"), will meet at Suite 200, 4010 Regent Street, in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia on **Monday, the 30<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2012** at the hour of 9:00 in the forenoon for the purpose of taking evidence or otherwise causing an inquiry to be made with respect to the allegation herein pursuant to the **Engineers and Geoscientists Act**, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 116, as amended (the "**Act**").

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the allegations against you are that, contrary to the **Act**, you have demonstrated unprofessional conduct by your failure to provide the Association's Investigation Committee with the requested information or records, in your possession or control, as required by section 30(4) of the **Act**, particulars of which are you failed to respond to the following requests for information:

1. letter to you dated October 5, 2011 regarding APEGBC File No. T11-025;
2. email to you dated October 31, 2011 regarding APEGBC File No. T11-025;
3. email delivery notifications October 6, 2011 and October 31, 2011 regarding APEGBC File No. T11-025

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that you, Paullus Yeung, P.Eng., have the right, at your own expense, to be represented by counsel at the inquiry by the Panel of the Discipline Committee and you or your counsel shall have the full right to cross-examine all witnesses called and to call evidence in defence and reply in answer to the allegation.

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that in the event of your non-attendance at the inquiry, the Panel of the Discipline Committee may, upon proof of service of this Notice of Hearing upon you, proceed with the taking of evidence or otherwise ascertaining the facts concerning the allegation, despite your absence, and may make its findings on the facts and its decision without further notice to you.
