

**RESTRICTION OF PRACTICE RIGHTS – JAIME TORRES, P.ENG,
KELOWNA, B.C.**

A complaint was made to the Association relating to fire suppression/sprinkler engineering services Mr. Torres provided for Phase 1 of a retirement complex in Salmon Arm, B.C. Deficiencies in Mr. Torres' design were detected during the construction of Phase 2 and have been corrected. The complaint was investigated by the designated reviewer and the Investigation Committee, which recommended an inquiry be held.

The Discipline Committee has approved an agreement that, in lieu of the Association proceeding with the disciplinary inquiry, Mr. Torres will cease practising in the area of fire suppression and sprinkler engineering effective July 31, 2006 and will transfer any on-going projects to other members qualified to practice in this area. If at some point in the future Mr. Torres wishes to remove his practice restriction, he may do so on proof of further training in fire suppression and sprinkler engineering acceptable to the Registrar of the Association.
