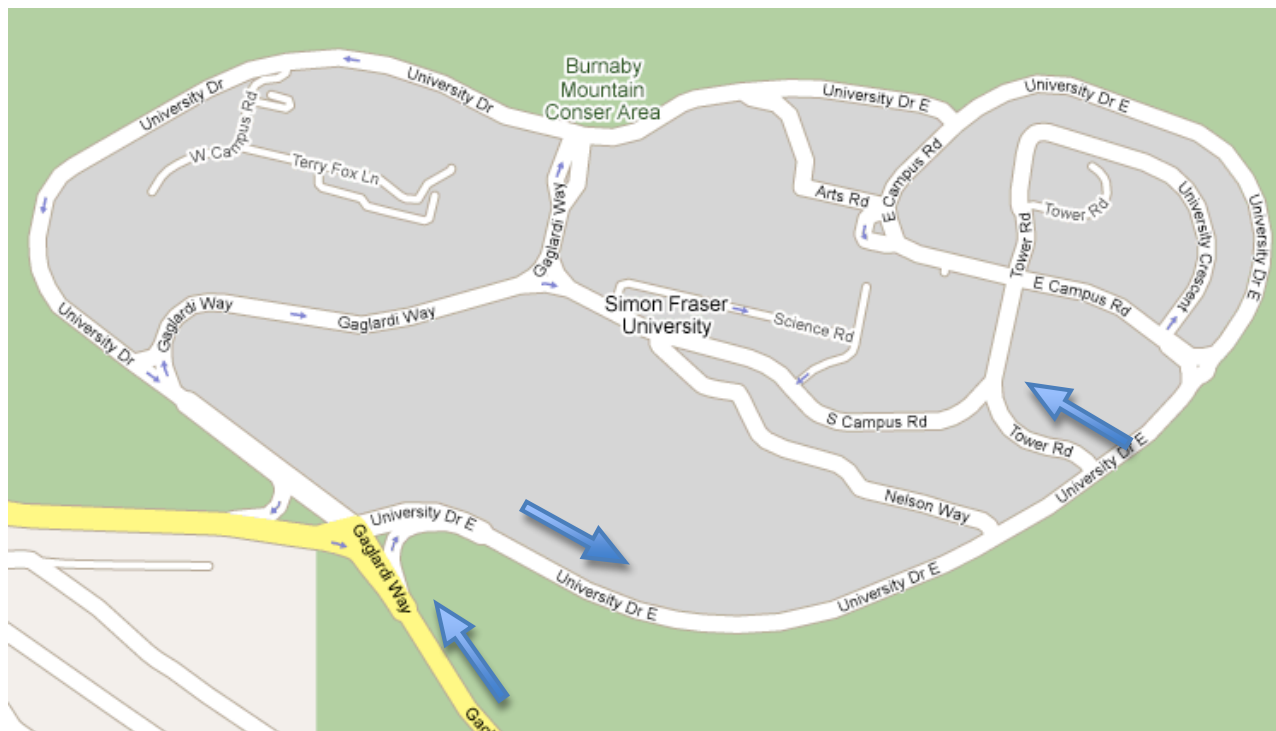


Math Challengers

Directions to SFU

SFU

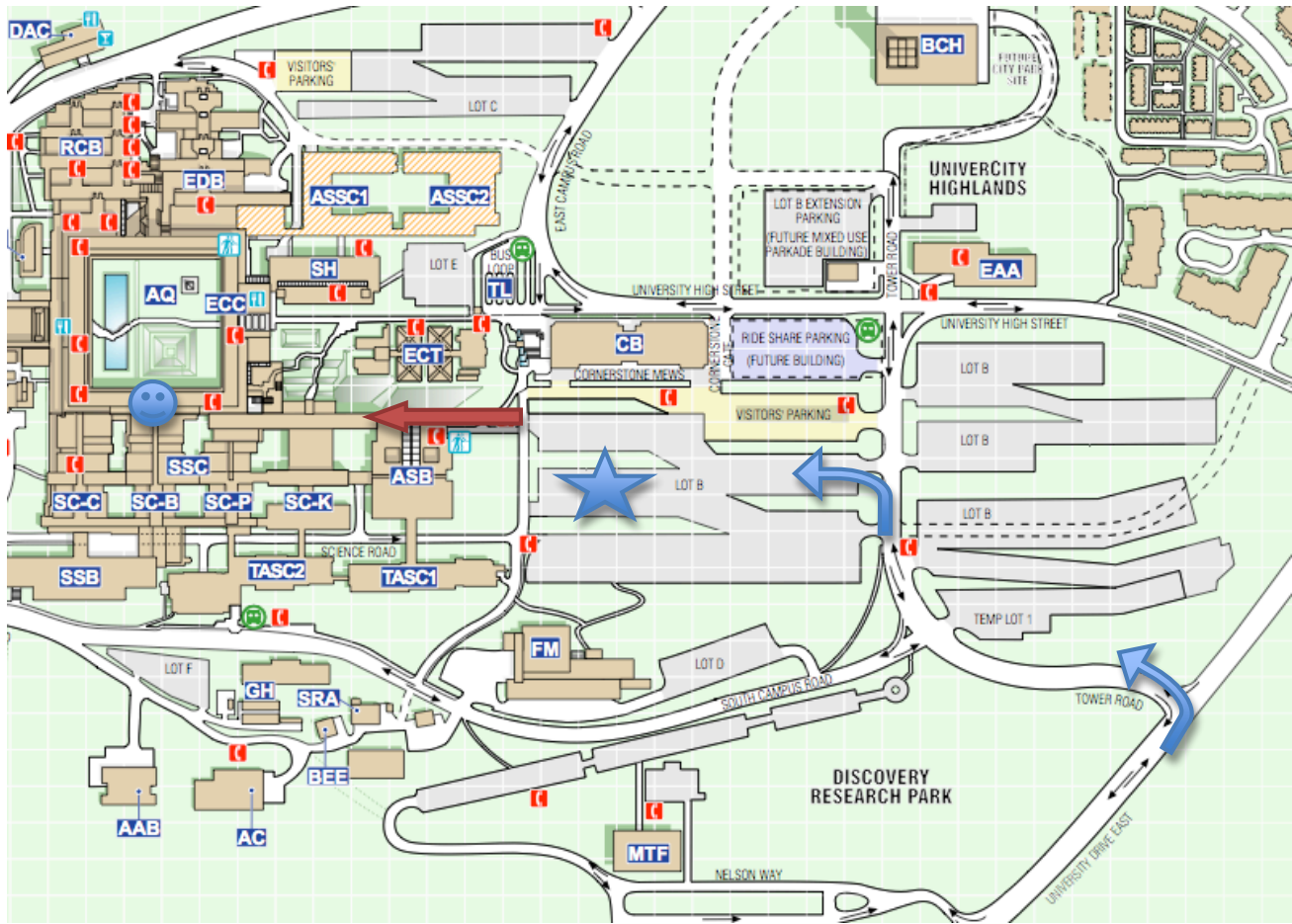


Driving:

1. Get to SFU (Either via Gaglardi Way or Burnaby Mountain Parkway/Hastings St.)
2. From Burnaby Mountain parkway go straight through the traffic lights at the top of the hill. From Gaglardi way, turn Right at the lights at the top of the hill (first arrow)
3. Take University Dr. E about 1km and turn Left at Tower Road (continued next page...)

Bus:

Taking the bus to SFU is easy and is part of the true student experience. It's easy. Find out the best bus route for you www.translink.bc.ca. Get off at SFU Loop (the last stop). You are now at the SFU Bus Loop (it's above the red arrow on the map). Head South, down the stairs and follow the directions into the Applied Science Building below (#6).



Driving Directions Continued...

4. Turn Left into B Lot (1st or 2nd turn after South Campus Road – DO NOT park in ‘Visitor’s’ Lot – this is an hourly/daily pay lot)
5. Park (You are a Star)! Walk to the Western Edge of the parking lot. Because you are our guest, parking is free!
6. Enter the building through the Applied Sciences Building (red arrow)
7. Go straight down the hall past the coffee kiosk. You will then come to a large concourse on your right. This is the AQ Concourse. You should see the registration table once you head down the three steps to your right.
