LIMITED LICENCE

Lamont Mark Hurd has signed an undertaking and is therefore authorized to engage in the practice of Professional Engineering in the Province of British Columbia, within the limited scope as specified hereunder:

Design review, project management, construction management, and pavement renewal and rehabilitation evaluations within the civil discipline for municipal land development projects, all in accordance with standard, published, municipal requirements, and limited to the following works (hereinafter known as the ‘defined works’): water distribution, sewage collection and conveyance, and urban roadways.

Limitations:

- 1. Project managing, reporting on, directing and supervising the construction and maintenance of the defined works.**
- 2. Performing technical analyses, including scope, operating conditions, technical merit, and fiscal feasibility. Evaluating pavement maintenance and replacement options.**
- 3. Coordinating designs of registered professionals in municipal servicing or industrial and residential land development. Ascertaining that submitted designs substantially comply with applicable enactments, bylaws, standards of practice, and specifications.**
- 4. Issuing technical specifications and contract documents for tendering and construction.**
- 5. Commissioning and accepting of the public works by ensuring adherence to quality assurance standards, monitoring of construction for adherence to the contract documents, certifying payment for work, and certifying the record drawings.**
