LIMITED LICENCE

Catherine Jean Mohoruk has signed an undertaking and is therefore authorized to engage in the practice of Professional Engineering in the Province of British Columbia, within the limited scope as specified hereunder:

Traffic and transportation engineering including computation of traffic generation and flow data, and application to the planning, evaluation and operations management of transportation networks (streets, highways, transit, pedestrian, cycling) and abutting land uses.

Limitations:

- Cost estimation and benefit-cost analysis of transportation projects are for the purpose of evaluating and comparing conceptual plans (i.e. not for inclusion as a final construction estimate).
- Planning and evaluation of light rail rapid transit is limited to ridership, conceptual routing, and site impact analyses.

Exclusions:

- Planning, operating or evaluating facilities that relate to air travel, heavy rail or marine operations except where these modes interact with road systems (e.g. rail crossing warrants for roadways).
- Roadway geometric design assignments, which consist of preparing detailed design drawings and specification documents for highway construction.
- Design of structures such as bridges and pedestrian/cycling overpasses, tunnels, elevated light rail rapid transit systems.
- Detailed design of traffic signal systems and electronic signs as part of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) projects.
