## LIMITED LICENCE

**Michael Seymour** has signed an undertaking and is therefore authorized to engage in the practice of Professional Engineering in the Province of British Columbia, within the limited scope as specified hereunder:

**Professional engineering within the civil discipline, limited to: provision of civil infrastructure (roads, water, drainage, sewage) required for the development of residential, commercial and institutional areas, all in accordance with standard municipal and applicable provincial and federal Regulations and Acts.**

## **Limitations:**

- 1. The detailed design of roads (up to collectors), water mains, site grading, parking lots, storm water detention & infiltration facilities, construction siltation ponds, storm and sanitary sewers, playing field drainage, artificial-wetlands (subsurface flow) and drainage, and pre-engineered water and wastewater systems up to 300 m<sup>3</sup>/day average flow including ground discharge systems, all in accordance with standard design criteria commonly prescribed in typical municipal requirements for on-site development and applicable provincial and federal Regulations and Acts.**
- 2. The issuance of technical specifications and contract documents as necessary for the tendering and construction of the above described infrastructure.**
- 3. Administration of construction contracts for the above described infrastructure, including monitoring of construction for adherence to the contract documents, certifications and payment for the work performed, and certification of the Record Drawings.**
- 4. Design of water and wastewater pumping systems typically provided and engineered in consultation with the appropriate equipment suppliers.**
