Guide to Determining a Limitation Restricting the Scope of Professional Practice

The professional services which the holder of a limited licence may perform are defined and described in terms of function, product and application. Restrictions to the scope of professional practice are imposed in terms of these three elements. Specifically, the professional services performed by the holder of the limited licence must be restricted, confined or limited with respect to one of the following: Function, product or application.

In order to determine whether your requested limitation is acceptable, the Association requires that you complete this form, as concisely as possible, and submit it with your application.

FUNCTION: Indicate which activity (activities) described in the definition of the practice of professional engineering or the practice of professional geoscience best describes the work you perform.

PRODUCT: What do you produce or what service do you provide?

APPLICATION: What is the end use of the product or service you provide?

THE PROPOSED WORDING OF YOUR LIMITATION: Must describe a specialized function, or an activity confined to a specific product or application. Your limitation must not be so broad as to cover all aspects of practice within an entire engineering or geoscience discipline.

Who currently assumes responsibility for the engineering or geoscience work described in your limitation?

Is this person licensed in order to comply with the requirements of the *Engineers and Geoscientists Act*? If not, please explain.
