



Designated Structural Engineer Active Practice Declaration

Please read the following carefully before signing below:

The Designated Structural Engineer status requires continuing active practice of all members who hold the designation. 'Active practice' means the practice of professional engineering as defined by The Engineers and Geoscientists Act of BC. At least 750 hours are required in structural and related engineering annually. Should a member not demonstrate the required continuing active practice, his or her status as a Designated Structural Engineer may be revoked by APEGBC.
