# Forest Engineering Award of Excellence

## Terms of Reference

The Forest Engineering Award of Excellence, which recognizes excellence and promotes cooperation and leadership in forest engineering, is sponsored jointly by the Association of BC Forest Professionals (ABC FP) and APEGBC. This annual award is presented by each association in alternate years at its Annual General Meeting.

Nominees may be individuals, organizations or associations responsible for projects that have demonstrated or represent outstanding accomplishments in forest engineering. Individuals must be members of ABCFP or APEGBC; organizations and associations must be recognized as being associated with professional forestry, professional engineering or professional geoscience.

To be eligible, projects must have been completed within the past two years and carried out by, or under the supervision of, a member of either association. Nominees must be either residents of BC or work for a BC-based firm, or the work must have been carried out in British Columbia. A management, academic

or research contribution, or the life work of an individual, may also be considered.

The award selection committee consists of one member from each association as well as a third member selected by, and drawn from, the association presenting the award.

Nominations may be received from any member of either association. They must be submitted on the prescribed form and contain the names and signatures of three registered members of either association, accompanied by a one-page statement outlining the reasons for the nomination along with supporting information such as CVs, project outlines, letters of reference and news clippings.

The nomination deadline for the 2009 Forest Engineering Award of Excellence is **July 17, 2009**.
