Kodak Annacis Manufacturing Facility **Directions**

From Downtown Vancouver to Kodak Annacis: 40 minutes

- Turn east onto Georgia Street and south onto Cambie Street
- Proceed over the Cambie Street Bridge and travel south to South West Marine Drive, turn east
- Follow Marine Way over the Queensborough Bridge, keep left to go onto the Bridge
- Go past one traffic light, move into right lane for Annacis Island exit
- Turn right onto Annacis Island exit, keep right (west), go past McDonald's and follow Cliveden to the end. Kodak Annacis will be on the left hand side.

From Burnaby to Kodak Annacis:

- Drive south on Boundary Road
- Follow Boundary Road to Marine Way, turn left onto Marine Way
- Follow Marine Way over the Queensborough Bridge, keep left to go onto the Bridge
- Go past one traffic light, move into right lane for Annacis Island exit
- Turn right onto Annacis Island exit, keep right (west), go past McDonald's and follow Cliveden to the end. Kodak Annacis will be on the left hand side.
