

Why I Love Engineering or Geoscience Video Contest:

APEGBC wants you to show the world why you love Engineering or Geoscience! Send us your video on “Why I Love Engineering or Geoscience” to enter our contest for a chance to win a trip to APEGBC’s Annual Conference & Annual General Meeting in Kelowna BC on October 14-16, 2011 and a \$1000 prize. APEGBC’s Annual Conference is a great place to network and interact with some of BC’s leading Professional Engineers and Geoscientists.

How will we use the videos?

APEGBC will post the eligible videos (the “Entries”) on a dedicated YouTube page. The winning Entry will be shown at APEGBC’s 2011 Annual Conference.

Format:

Entries must be no longer than 2 minutes in length and in AVI format. Entries should clearly answer the question “Why I love Engineering or Geoscience”.

Eligibility to Participate:

This contest is open to students enrolled in an Engineering or Geoscience undergraduate program in BC (“Entrants”) who are returning to undergraduate studies in September 2011. In the case of Entries created by teams, there is a maximum of three Entrants per Entry.

Deadline:

Entries must be submitted by Friday, September 16, 2011 at 4:30pm.

Judging:

The winning Entry will be chosen by the APEGBC Editorial Board. The winning Entrants will be notified by September 30, 2011. We are looking for creative videos that clearly show why you love Engineering or Geoscience.

Prize for Winning Entry:

The winning Entry will receive a trip to APEGBC’s 2011 Annual Conference & AGM in Kelowna BC for each Entrant (max. 3) and a \$1000 cash prize (1 per Entry).* *Certain travel restrictions do apply.*

Submission Information:

Contest Rules:

- a. Entry must be no longer than 2 minutes (submissions that exceed 2 minutes will not be considered).
- b. Entries must be uploaded to APEGBC's FTP site by 4:30 pm on September 16, 2011
- c. Entrants must agree in writing to these Contest Rules and submit a completed Application Form. In the case of an Entry submitted by a team (max. 3 Entrants per team), the Application Form must specify a Primary Entrant.
- d. All Entrants must be undergraduate students enrolled in an Engineering or Geoscience undergraduate program in BC and returning to undergraduate studies in September 2011.
- e. All Application Forms must be submitted by September 16, 2011.
- f. In the event that the winning Entry has more than one Entrant, the cash prize will be awarded to the Primary Entrant and it will be the responsibility of the Primary Entrant to distribute the prize to the other Entrants on his/her team.
- g. The Entry must be Entrant's or Entrants' own original work and content, created solely and wholly by the Entrant(s); must not have been previously published, released or distributed in any form; must not have won any other award; and must not infringe the copyright, trademark, privacy, publicity, or other personal or proprietary rights of any person or entity. In particular, but without limiting the foregoing, any music used in the Entry must be original and/or not require any further permission or authorization for use, reproduction or posting on public websites or to use in public forums of any kind. **ANY ENTRY CONTAINING MUSIC, VIDEO, OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL THAT INFRINGES THE RIGHTS OF ANY PERSON OR ENTITY WILL BE REJECTED AUTOMATICALLY.**
- h. By submitting an Entry, each Entrant warrants that their Entry does not infringe on the privacy, copyright or other intellectual property of third parties, and does not violate any law or regulation of British Columbia or Canada. Each Entrant hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless APEGBC, and APEGBC's directors, officers, employees, agents and assigns, from all fines, suits, judgments, claims, demands or actions of any kind or nature whatsoever, including but not limited to all legal fees, arising or otherwise connected with any intellectual property in the Entry.
- i. Any music used in the Entry must be original and/or not require any further permission or authorization for use, reproduction or posting on public websites or to use in public forums of any kind.
- j. If any persons appear or are referred to in the Entry, the Entrant is solely responsible for obtaining consent, prior to submitting the Entry.
- k. Entries that, in the sole determination of APEGBC, are lewd, obscene, sexually explicit, pornographic, disparaging, defamatory, libelous, or that otherwise contain inappropriate content or objectionable material, will be rejected.

- l. Entries must not contain or reference any names, products or services of any company or entity or any third party trademarks, logos, trade dress or promotion of any brand, product or service.
- m. If APEGBC does not receive, in its sole opinion, Entries of sufficient quantity or quality, it reserves the right not to award any prizes.
- n. All Entries become the sole property of APEGBC. By submitting an Entry, the Entrant(s) assigns all right, title and interest, including copyright, to APEGBC, and waive all moral rights in favour of APEGBC except the right to have their name remain associated with the Entry.
- o. All Entries become the sole property of APEGBC and in submitting an Entry, all rights and interests of the Entrant(s) in their Entry are released in favour of APEGBC.
- p. In order to verify all Entrants are registered in an undergraduate engineering or geoscience program and therefore qualify for this contest, APEGBC will contact each Entrant's school to verify their enrollment. No additional information will be gathered. By submitting this contest form, you agree to allow APEGBC to use your student number to verify your enrollment for the purposes of qualifying you for this contest only.
