(For those first year students entering their second term in the Engineering
Transfer Program at Thompson Rivers University, Kamloops BC)**

APEGBC Foundation offers several entry scholarships to British Columbia high school graduates entering engineering transfer programs at post secondary institutions in BC.

The South Central Branch of APEGBC established this scholarship specifically to support the Engineering Transfer Program at Thompson Rivers University. This scholarship, valued at \$1000, is awarded on the basis of a combination of factors. Applications are evaluated on the basis of academic standing, extracurricular activities, financial need and student statement.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution upon confirmation of registration in second term courses. The successful applicant will be contacted by APEGBC Foundation and will be able to pick-up their award from the Financial Aid and Awards Office of Thompson Rivers University.

Academic Requirements

Admission requirements for high school graduates entering engineering transfer programs at BC post secondary institutions typically require:

- Mathematics 12
- Physics 12
- Chemistry 12
- English 12

Applicants are also required to be entering the second term of study in the first year of the Engineering Transfer Program.

Student's Statement – 15% of total

Please include a letter, stating in your own words why you wish to study engineering. Please relate your views on how engineering is impacting society. This is an important factor in selection: choose your words carefully. Your statement should not exceed 500 words.

Academics – 30% of total

Overall Presentation – 15% of total

Personal References

Please provide **two** letters of reference (not from relatives) who may be contacted by the Foundation Trustees. Please provide full name, address, and contact telephone number below.

Reference letters may come from:

- a high school teacher, student counselor or principal who knows you and your achievements personally
- an instructor at Thompson Rivers University
- a member of APEGBC (Professional Engineer or Professional Geoscientist). If this is not possible, a prominent member of your community.
